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The Sybil B. Harrington College of Fine Arts and Humanities offers coursework, laboratory preparation and real-life experience in humanities and fine arts. Students studying in fine arts and humanities departments can prepare for professional careers as performers, clinicians, writers and critics, as well as for careers in university and public education.

The college also offers a strong liberal arts foundation for students who wish to pursue traditional, broadly based university goals with emphasis in fine arts or humanities. A wide range of general courses is available for students seeking some background in fine arts and humanities while majoring in one of the University's other academic disciplines.

The mission of the college is to nurture and maintain fine arts and humanities throughout the region through teaching, research, professional assistance and creative endeavor. Ultimately, the Sybil B. Harrington College of Fine Arts and Humanities exists to foster and preserve the art of human expression.

Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences (B.A.A.S.) Degree

Major in Applied Arts and Sciences (Major Code: 601)

This degree assumes completion of an associate of applied science degree at a community college or completion of an appropriate occupational certificate prior to starting work on the B.A.A.S. degree at WTAMU. Included in this credit must be a block transfer of technical-vocational credits, up to a maximum of 48 hours. Additionally, hours of academic credit may be transferred along with the block to total 66 hours, the maximum number of hours accepted from a community college.

Also required are completion of the core curriculum (42 hours) and fulfillment of other University requirements, including 36 advanced hours, 30 in residence at WTAMU, for a total of 123 semester hours with a minimum grade point average of 2.0. This degree includes a professional development core of 18–24 semester hours, specified through advisement and listed on the individual student's degree plan. At least 12 of these hours must be 3000- and 4000-level courses. The degree plan should be requested as soon as a student enters the B.A.A.S. program.

Major in Emergency Management Administration (Major Code: 603)

The emergency management administration (EMA) program awards a professional management education to firefighters, emergency medical service providers and law-enforcement personnel through Internet classes. The EMA program's goal is to prepare students for advanced levels of administration and management within the emergency services professions.

The emergency management administration degree program was specially designed by West Texas A&M University in cooperation with the Texas Engineering Extension Service for non-traditional students who can complete the program while remaining employed full time in governmental or industrial emergency management positions. WTAMU's four-year emergency management program is the only four-year professional emergency management program in the state of Texas combining the curriculums of public administration and business management.

The degree plan requires completion of an associate's degree at a community college or completion of appropriate technical-education courses at accredited technical-education facilities such as the National Fire Academy. WTAMU can receive the transfer of up to 66 credit hours from community colleges or technical-education facilities. Within the 66 hours, up to 48 hours of credit can be provided for technical courses that otherwise would not receive academic credit from WTAMU.

To be eligible for the emergency management administration program, a prospective student must have technical credit from a community college or technical-education facility, must be currently employed in an emergency management profession and must have at least five years experience in an emergency management position.

The emergency management administration major requires completion of a general education core curriculum of 42 credit hours, many of which may have been completed at a community college. The degree includes 42 credit hours of advanced professional-development courses within a 123-semester hour degree plan. Many non-traditional students also transfer credit hours from other four-year universities in Texas and around the nation. To receive a degree from WTAMU, at least 32 hours must be taken from WTAMU. Because the hours transferred to WTAMU are unique to each student, a student should request a formal degree plan immediately after being admitted to WTAMU.

Bachelor of General Studies (B.G.S.) Degree (Major Code: 136)

For the B.G.S. degree, the student must complete, in addition to the core curriculum, a minimum of 81 hours of electives, including at least 36 hours at the advanced level. A maximum of 36 hours in one academic discipline can count toward this degree. An academic discipline is designated by a course prefix, as ENGL for English or POSC for political science. Music courses, whether MUSI (music) or MUAP (applied music), are counted as one academic discipline. No major or minor is required for the B.G.S. degree.

General Information for Art Students

- Outside work is required in all studio classes. The Department of Art, Communication and Theatre reserves the right, with permission of the student, to retain class work for instructional purposes and for a permanent collection of student work.
- Foundation studio core referred to in some prerequisite consists of ARTS 1316, 1317, 1311, 1312, 1303 and 1304.
- Courses for non-art majors requiring no prerequisite consist of ARTS 1372, 1373, 1374, 3372, 3373, 3374, 4370 and 4371.
- ARTS 1372, 1373, 1374, 3372, 3373 and 3374 provide non-art background studio experiences in drawing, oil painting, watercolor painting, printmaking, sculpture, jewelry, ceramics, glass blowing, graphic design and computer art.

NOTE: Students will be required to purchase all paints, brushes, rulers, paper, canvases, and necessary tools and supplies for all art courses.

Requirements

Studio art majors may choose their major and minor from the areas of drawing, painting, printmaking, graphic design, sculpture, metalsmithing/jewelry, ceramics, glass and computer art.

All studio majors are required to have a one- or two-person, one-week show featuring work from their 4394 project. The student will be responsible for design and mounting of the show, arrangements for publicity through the University's Office of Communication Services and *The Prairie* student newspaper, and handling invitations. An opening reception is optional. Each student will undergo a critique of the show by a committee of three or more persons (the student's faculty adviser and at least two additional faculty members from the department).

Each graphic design major is required to have a portfolio review and may, with departmental approval, mount an exhibition (one or more persons) if the student desires. The review committee will consist of the student's major adviser and at least one department faculty member chosen by the student. If the student chooses to exhibit, the same guidelines will be followed as for studio major exhibits.
