

Common Course Numbering

The Texas Common Course Numbering (TCCN) System was established to help facilitate the transferability of courses between participating institutions. A list of common course numbers, consisting of a four-letter abbreviation and a four-digit number, follows. Common course numbers also are included in departmental course listing.
