
Where are Journals and Magazines Located in the Cornette Library?

Journals and magazines are located on the 2nd floor. They are shelved in order alphabetically by title—no need to know a call number! They may not be checked out by WTAMU students, but you may photocopy or scan articles.


Currently they are in three locations on the 2nd floor:

- ▶ Current Periodicals
- ▶ Bound Periodicals
- ▶ Microfilm/Microfiche



The **Current Periodicals** are loose issues—the most recent issues that the library has received. They may not be checked out by students.




The **Bound Periodicals** look like a hard-bound book. Loose issues have been sewn together and bound with a durable buckram cover. The name of the journal is printed on the spine of the book. They may not be checked out by students.



Microfilm is a reel of film that has one miniature image for every page of a journal or magazine.

Microfiche also has one miniature image for every page of a journal, but the images are on a sheet instead of a reel.

Microfilm and microfiche can only be viewed/copied using a microform reader/printer. They may not be checked out by students.



Finding a Journal or Magazine on the Shelf

Journals and magazines do not have a call number. They are shelved in order **alphabetically by title**.

The Journal of Fluency Disorders will be shelved under “Journal” not “The”:

Journal of Fluency Disorders

After the initial *The*, do not ignore the word *the* in the title of a journal. Notice where the title *American Annals of the Deaf* would be found on a shelf:

American Annals of History

American Annals of the Deaf

American Annals of Westward Expansion

Issues of a journal in the library can be in three locations (Current, Bound, Microform). For example, issues of the *American Journal of Speech-Language Pathology* are in two locations:

▶ Current Periodicals Shelves (1991 – 1998)

▶ Micro “Room” – Microfiche Cabinets (1999 – 2012)

Check the citation for your article to choose the correct location for your article. Please ask any library staff member for help if you cannot find the journal you need.
