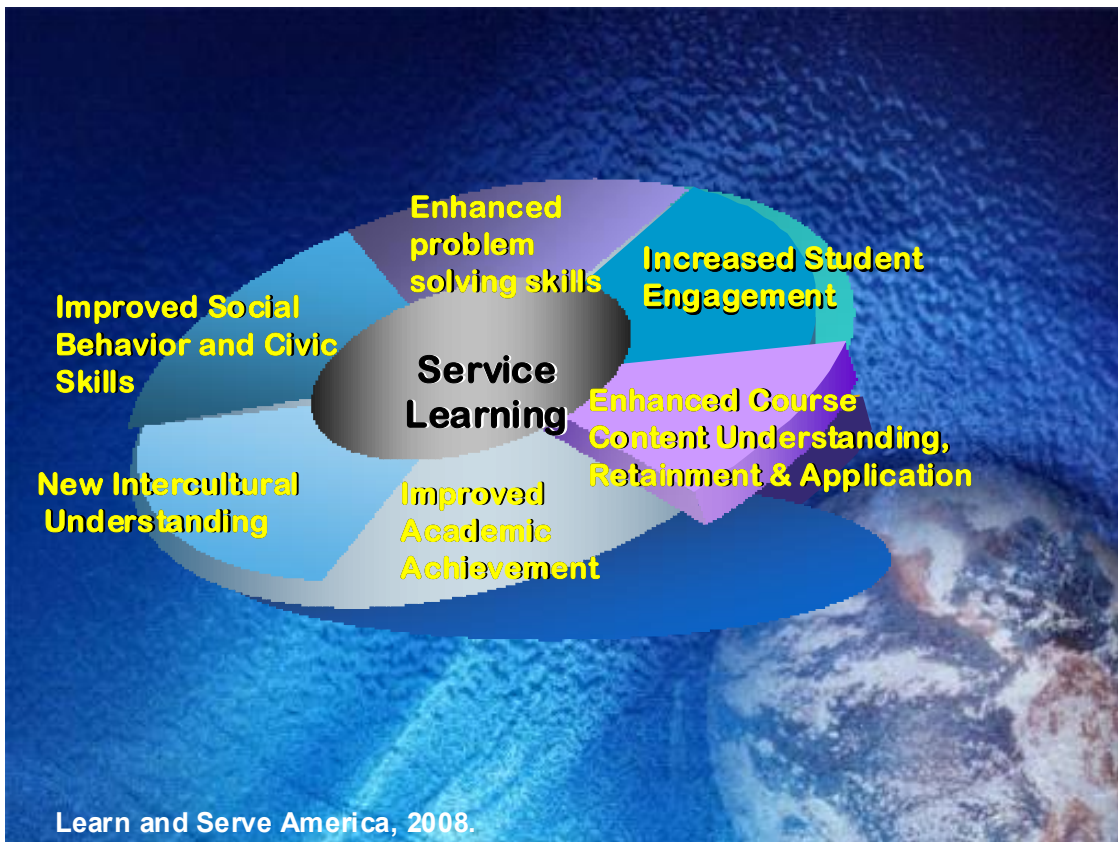


Go Global Service Leadership
