**GRADUATE CLASS TUITION =** Students enrolled in 5000 and higher level classes pay an additional **\$50.00** per semester credit hour in tuition.

**GRADUATE DESIGNATED TUITION =** Students enrolled in 5000 and higher level classes pay an additional **\$17.89** per semester credit hour in tuition.

The Out of State waiver is given to all out of state students their first semester. However, an undergraduate student who drops below a cumulative 2.0 in their chosen program will no longer be eligible for the waiver. Graduate students must maintain a 3.0 to maintain eligibility for the waiver. Students who fall below the minimum requirement will be notified by the Office of the Registrar, and will be billed at Non-Resident amounts without applied waiver given on the rate tables, (white column above).
