BACTERIAL MENINGITIS VACCINATION EXEMPTION REQUEST FORM FOR ONLINE ONLY STUDENTS

Texas Senate Bill 1107 requires that all first-time, transferring or returning students attending an institution of higher education provide evidence of vaccination against bacterial meningitis being administered during the five-year period preceding, or at least 10 days prior to the first day of the semester of enrollment, unless they qualify for an approved exemption.

This form must be submitted at least 10 days prior to the start of the semester in which you seek to enroll or you will not be allowed to register or attend classes. Please mark the appropriate exemption below.

I understand that I must file this exemption (online only) every semester I am enrolled and if at any time I enroll in a face-to-face course on the campus in Canyon or at the Amarillo Center, I must then provide documentation of vaccination at least 10 days prior to the start of the semester. Failure to do so can result in administrative withdrawal for the semester involved.
