I. STATEMENT

WTAMU must ensure that publicly-accessible information systems do not contain non-public information. Additionally, the University must review the proposed content of publicly-accessible information and remove non-public information prior to posting onto the organization's information systems. Individuals must be authorized to post content onto an organizational information system that is publicly accessible.

II. APPLICABILITY

This Control applies to all West Texas A&M network information resources. The intended audience for this Control includes all information resource owners, custodians, and users of information resources.

III. IMPLEMENTATION

Web content editors must be authorized and trained by the Marketing and Communications department. Information Technology and the Marketing and Communications department will periodically review publicly accessible web material for nonpublic or inappropriate information.
