PRE-BUSINESS:

Students must complete these courses with a grade of "C" or better before declaring a Business major: ENGL 1301; MATH 1324 and 1325; COMM 1321 or ENGL 1302; ECON 2301 and 2302; CIDM 1315 or equivalent; ACCT 2301.

PREREQUISITE NOTES:

ACCT 2302: ACCT 2301.

ACCT 3311: ACCT 2302.

BUSI 3312: junior standing.

BUSI 3319: MGT 3330, MKT 3340, junior standing.

CIDM 2342: MATH 1325 or permission of instructor.

CIDM 3330: CIDM 2342 or concurrent enrollment.

ECON 4351: ECON 2301 and ECON 2302.

EDPD 3340: 54 hours, pass TSI, minimum 2.5 GPA.

EDPD 4340: GPA 2.5; lack no more than two courses in teaching field, lack no more than 15 semester hours for completion of degree/deficiency plan program (excluding student teacher courses).

EDRD 4386: EDPD 3340, EPSY 3341 and admission to and retention in WTAMU Teacher Education Program, pass TSI.

EDSE 4320: EDPD 3340, EPSY 3341, EDT 3343, full admission to Teacher Education Program.

EDSE 4340 and 4341: lack no more than two courses in teaching field, lack no more than 15 semester hours for completion of degree (excluding student teacher courses), enrollment in a minimum of 6 credit hours of student teaching courses.

EDT 3343: demonstrated computer competency or equivalent and minimum of 60 semester hours.

EPSY 3341: EDPD 3340, minimum 2.5 GPA, admission into WTAMU Teacher Education Program.

ENGL 1302 and 2311: ENGL 1301.

FIN 3320: ACCT 2301, 2302 or concurrent enrollment, and CIDM 2342 or concurrent enrollment.

FIN 3350: FIN 3320

MATH 1324: MATH 0303 or a score of 85 or higher on Accuplacer Elementary Level Algebra.

MATH 1325: MATH 1324 (or 1314 if student already has credit).

MGT 4315: FIN 3320, MGT 3330, MKT 3340, and senior standing.
