CAVEAT: This course sequence is based on course descriptions in the 2012-13 university catalog, the two-year course rotation, and the 2012 spring and 2012 fall schedule of classes, so it is very much subject to change.

NOTES:

FOUNDATION CORE is the goal during the freshman year for an art major:

- ARTS 1311 (two-dimensional design) and ARTS 1316 (drawing I) plus one of the art history courses (1303 or 1304) in the fall semester.
- ARTS 1312 (three-dimensional design) and ARTS 1317 (drawing II) plus one of the art history courses in the spring semester.
- ARTS 1303 and 1304 do NOT have to be taken in sequence. If developmental courses are needed, ARTS 1303/1304 can be delayed.

¹**ARTS 1312:** prerequisite is ARTS 1311

²**ARTS 1317:** prerequisite is ARTS 1316

³**INTERMEDIATE CORE** is the goal for the sophomore year:

- Completion of the FOUNDATION CORE (ARTS 1311, 1312, 1316, 1317, 1303, 1304) is the prerequisite for all INTERMEDIATE CORE courses.
- Transfer students who do not have the foundation core completed must see an instructor of an intermediate core course to get blue-carded into the course.
- Take six courses from: ARTS 2313 (Graphic Design I, fall); ARTS 2323 (Drawing III, fall); ARTS 2316 (Painting I, fall/spring) or ARTS 2366 (Watermedia I, spring); ARTS 2326 (Sculpture I, fall); ARTS 2333 (Printmaking I, spring); ARTS 2346 (Ceramics I, fall/spring); ARTS 2375 (Glass I, fall/spring); ARTS 2377 (Computer Art I, fall/spring).

⁴MAJOR AREA:

- Beginning with the junior year, the student concentrates on a MAJOR AREA and a minor area for four semesters.
- For MAJOR AREA, take four courses (two with the 3000 number and two with the 4000 number; the prerequisite is the 2000 number)
 - Drawing (ARTS 3323 X 2, 4323 X 2)
 - Painting (ARTS 3316 X 2, 4316 X 2)
 - Printmaking (ARTS 3333 X 2, 4333 X 2)
 - Graphic design (ARTS 3313 X 2, 4313 X 2)
 - Sculpture (ARTS 3326 X 2, 4326 X 2)
 - Ceramics (ARTS 3346 X 2, 4346 X 2)
 - Glass (ARTS 3375 X 2, 4375 X 2)
 - Computer art (ARTS 3377 X 2, 4377 X 2)
 - NOTE that painting, ceramics, glass, and computer art are the only courses that are offered both fall and spring.

⁵MINOR AREA:

- One of the above areas but only three courses, or
- Graphic design (ARTS 2313, 3313, 4313).
 - If graphic design, it must be decided in the fall semester of the sophomore year.

⁶**ARTS 4180:** All three one-hour enrollments are simultaneous. Take it whenever it appears.

⁷**ARTS 4394:** Completion of 60 hours of art and consent of instructor.
