CORE ROUNDTABLE MAN AND WOMAN OF THE YEAR 2010-2011

Each chartered organization is asked to submit one entry for consideration for this honor.

The guidelines for selection are:

- The nominee must have a minimum of junior, senior or graduate level status. (Junior status is 60 hours or more.)
- The nominee must be a full-time student (undergraduate enrolled in a minimum of 12 semester hours; graduate enrolled in a minimum of 9 semester hours.)
- The nominee must have a minimum cumulative g.p.a. of 2.5.
- The nominee must have a demonstrated record of participation and leadership in academic and extracurricular activities, citizenship, and service to WTAMU.
- A student may be nominated by more than one organization.

The nominated student must attend the Man & Woman of the Year Reception held Friday, April 29, 2011, at 6:00 p.m. on the Isley Terrace of the Alumni Banquet Facility. At the reception, the three finalists for each award will be announced. The Man & Woman of the Year will be presented at the All-University Honors Banquet, which immediately follows the reception at 7:00 p.m. in the Dr. Hazel Kelley Wilson Banquet Hall.

The Man & Woman of the Year awards are the top two awards for students at West Texas A&M University. The CORE Roundtable and Leadership Board are very aware of the honor of being chosen by one's peers as a nominee for this award. The CORE Roundtable and Leadership Board hope that each organization will honor one of its own by nominating a deserving man and woman in order to make the entire University community aware of his or her value to the organization.

Please have your nominee complete the attached application and submit it to the CORE Center, Suite 103 of the Jack B. Kelley Student Center.

Application must be limited to three (3) pages.
