- A \$100 deposit must be submitted with an application to reserve a room
- All residence halls are completely smoke free
- Conner Hall is the Honors Hall and only participants in the University Honors program may reside
- All rooms are equipped with MicroFridge units – No personal refrigerators or microwaves are allowed
- All rooms have internet access
- Cross, Jones, Guenther, and Shirley are air conditioned halls – All halls have air conditioned lobbies
- Rates include local telephone service, basic cable service, and Internet access
- Buff Hall is a four bedroom/two bath super-suite coed residence hall for upper classmen

- Tax is included in the meal plan prices
- Students may access the Dining Hall multiple times each day
- Meal Plan meals **do not carryover** from one semester to another, however unused Dining Dollars will roll from the Fall to the Spring semester if the student has a meal plan in the Spring semester - DD will not roll over at any other time
- Each Meal Plan includes five (5) guest meals
- Dining Dollars may be used in the JBK Food Court, Convenience Store, Buff Stop, or the Dining Hall

Payment Options

The University provides an option to pay an entire semester at once or use an optional payment plan (with an administrative fee). Room and board payment must be paid on the same plan selected for tuition and fees. Payments are made to the Business Office. The room deposit (\$100.00) should be submitted directly to the Residential Living Office along with the housing

application. The room deposit is not part of the residence hall cost and is separate and apart from any scholarships or financial aid received.

Cancellation Deadlines

In order to receive a refund of deposit, you must submit a **written cancellation letter or form** to the office of Residential Living prior to the following dates:

Fall – August 1
Summer I – May 15

Spring – December 15
Summer II – June 15

The only instance in which the university will refund a deposit after these deadlines is if the student is not admitted to the university for academic reasons.

University Housing Requirement

WTAMU requires all students to live in university housing, unless they have reached the age of 21 prior to the first day of class or have accumulated 60 or more credit hours by the first day of class, or are enrolled in fewer than nine credit hours for the fall or spring semester. Exemptions to this requirement may be pursued through the Office of Residential Living. Please contact the Office of Residential Living for additional information related to the exemption process.

Students under this requirement will have housing charges placed on their account unless they have an approved exemption on file.

Meal Plan Requirement

All students, under the age of 21, residing in on-campus housing **are required** to purchase a University meal plan until the student has accumulated 45 semester hours or have turned 21 prior to the first day of class. Exemptions to the requirement may be pursued through the Office of Residential Living. Please contact the Office of Residential Living for additional information related to the exemption process. Students under this requirement will have meal plan charges placed on their account unless they have an approved exemption on file.
