** While MATH 1332 and 1350 will fulfill core math requirements, they will NOT prepare students for higher-level math courses such as Plane Trigonometry (MATH 1316) or Pre-Calculus (MATH 2412).

***** Strongly recommended.

NOTE II: At least 39 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU, and 30 of the final 36 hours counted toward the degree must be earned at WTAMU. A maximum of 80 semester hours in music (MUSI, MUEN, MUAP), six hours in religion (REL) and six hours in physical education (PHED) can be counted toward a degree.

▲Transfer & WT GPA combined must be 2.75.

NOTE: This is NOT a degree plan. After completing 30 hours, students are encouraged to request an official degree plan by using the online [Degree Plan Request](#) form. The dean's office of the Sybil B. Harrington College of Fine Arts and Humanities, located in Mary Moody Northen Hall, Room 181 (or call 806-651-2782), can answer questions about the degree plan. *If developmental courses are needed, delay MUSI 1307 until the spring semester.

*Generally, a grade of "C" is required to advance to the next level of piano and theory/aural skills courses.

*MUSI 1311 + 1116/1312 + 1117/2311 + 2116/2312 + 2117 are concurrent enrollment courses.

*Enrollment in core curriculum courses, which should be completed as early as possible, during intersessions and summer sessions will reduce course loads during the fall and spring semesters.
