Advising Notes

Reverse Transfer

Did you know that you can transfer courses you take at WTAMU back to your community college for completion of your associate's degree? It's called reverse transfer and is a fairly simple process. Contact the Registrar's Office at WTAMU to have your WTAMU transcript sent to your community college (or you can take the transcript yourself). Then, speak with the Registrar's Office at your community college to have the WTAMU transcript evaluated and courses added to your community college degree plan.
