On 12/3/10 at approximately 1:30 p.m., it was reported to the University Police Department that an adult female was allegedly sexually assaulted in a residence hall on the West Texas A&M University campus. The alleged offense occurred between 7 p.m. - 10 p.m. Thursday, 12/2/10. The alleged offense involved an adult male suspect who is a WT student and was known to the victim. All appropriate resources were made available to the victim.

WTAMU and the University Police strongly encourage everyone to use good judgment and be an active player in your own safety and remember:

- Be aware of your surroundings at all times
- Group or public settings should always be used when meeting an online acquaintance or date for the first time
- Remember that alcohol begins to impair your judgment with the first drink

3. Preserve all physical evidence
4. Obtain medical attention
5. Report the assault to Police
