



HOW TO REGISTER

- Registration is only available online at panhandleplains.org.
- Go to panhandleplains.org/summercamp.
- Download the "TAMU Waiver." Fill out and upload under "Permission Form."
- Fill out the "Summer Camp Sign Up" and click "Submit with Waiver."
- Click on "Click Here to Pay" and select price type.
- Click "Add to Cart."
- Sign up under your name and in the "Notes" section add your child's name.
- Payment must be made at time of sign up. No reservations will be held without payment.
- Children cannot attend camp without a waiver, payment and sign-up form.

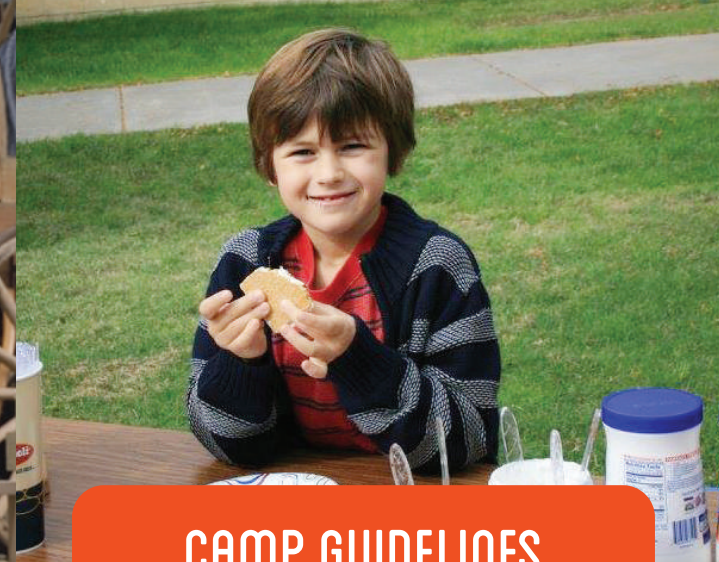
Don't forget to stock up on camp memories and purchase the PPHM Summer Camp pack for \$25, which includes a branded hat, drawstring bag and water bottle.



CAMP INFORMATION

Summer campers can expect a fun, organized environment led by PPHM staff and summer camp counselors.

- Children need to come dressed to play. Camp will offer a great time with activities planned for both inside and outside and on uneven surfaces.
- Check-in begins at 8:30 a.m., and campers will be placed in groups the first day. Each group will stay together throughout the week with one to two camp counselors in charge.
- Campers must be checked in and out each day by a parent for safety reasons.
- Completed forms and payments are required before a camper can check in.
- Each camper will receive a free Boulders, Brands, and Bones camp T-shirt.
- Camp T-shirts should be worn on Friday, June 29 for the Palo Duro Canyon field trip.



CAMP GUIDELINES

- Fun activities are planned so please no cell phones, valuables, toys, etc.
- Camp fees include all activities and a daily snack. Please indicate any allergies on the camp form.
