1:45 Every band student is required to enroll in one afternoon course offered at 1:45 p.m., each day selected from the following electives: **Marching Band Class** limited to students who will be in 8th grade or higher next year; **Rhythmic Reading Class**; **Drum Majoring** (beginning and advanced sections); **Jazz Improvisation** (limited to students entering 10th grade or higher); **HS Conducting**; **Theory Classes** (offered at beginning, intermediate, advanced levels, sectioned by faculty on first day of camp); **Flag Class** (student must provide own flag and pole); **Twirling/Dance Twirl**; **Double Reed Making** (student must bring own tools and materials)/ **HS and JH ensembles of like instrumentation** (such as HS Flute Ensemble or JH Clarinet Ensemble*, etc.) (*ensembles limited to students who will be in 8th grade or higher next year); and **HS Woodwind Ensemble***, **HS Brass Choir***, or **HS Percussion Ensemble*** (Membership in these three ensembles is determined at Monday's audition. Students who wish to be considered for these ensembles must enroll in a like-instrument ensemble as their first choice. If the student does not make the ensemble, he/she will be place in the line-instrument ensemble, or second choice in the case of HS percussion or double reed students.)
