Now. if you have a student who earns 105 points, which is the maximum, you can enter 105 points. If you set it up for percentages, you can't enter 105 points because it only allows for 100. If you set it up for percentages and you say 105% is the top, then a 70 is a 63.

The method I've shown you should work.
