



## **Timely Warning Notification: Campus Community Scam Alert**

The Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Act (Clery Act) is a federal law that requires colleges and universities across the United States to disclose information about crime on and around their campuses. A requirement of this law is timely notification to the campus community of certain crimes in a manner that will aid in the prevention of similar crimes.

### **Internet Scams**

UPD has recently received multiple reports of internet/cyber scams occurring across campus since July 2025, with incidents continuing. These scammers are primarily using social media platforms to request payments, personal information, or sensitive data such as banking details or photos.

To ensure your safety, please take precautions and follow the guidance below:

- **Do Not Share Sensitive Information:** Never share personal, financial, or banking details, passwords, or photos in response to unsolicited requests.
- **Report Suspicious Activity:** Immediately report any suspicious emails, calls, or messages to the campus IT department or UPD.
