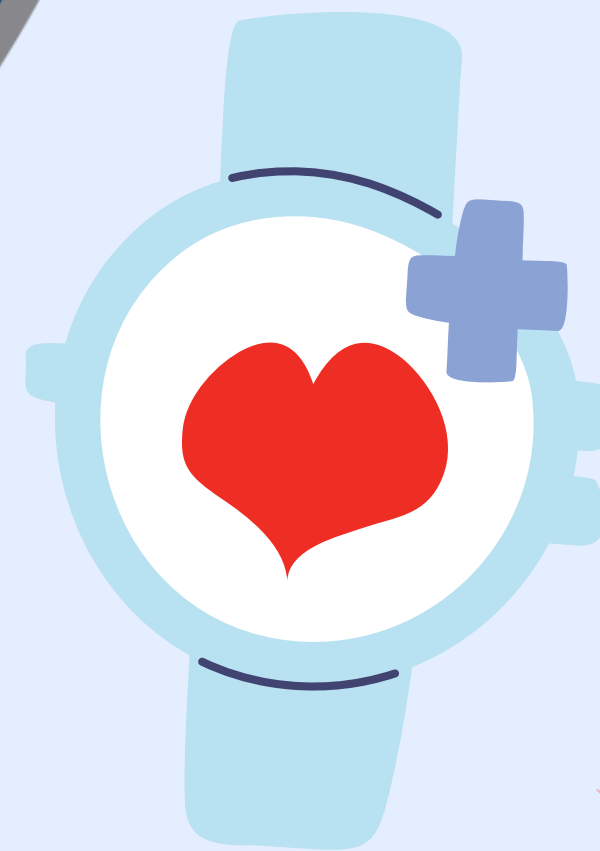
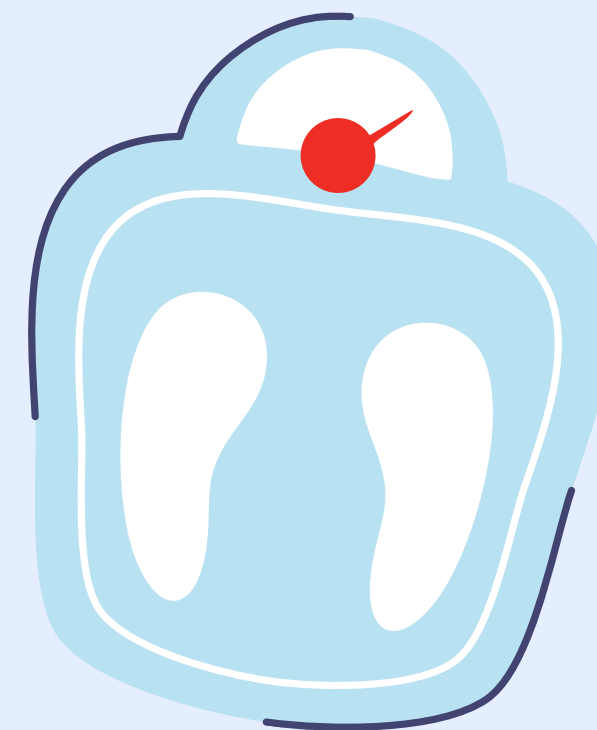

What We Do



Panhandle AHEC works closely with high schools, community colleges and universities, community-based healthcare professionals, and community leaders who share the same interests in addressing the healthcare provider shortage.

AHEC Scholars



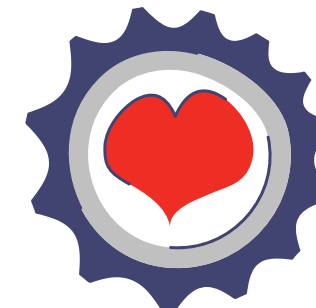
The AHEC Scholars program was developed as a national program grant funded through the Health Resource and Service Administration (HRSA).



The AHEC Scholars program selects students from eligible certificate, undergraduate, and graduate health professions programs who are interested in enhancing their education and experiences beyond the classroom.



Scholars gain knowledge and experiences in patient-centered team-based care and learn about unique challenges that face underserved rural and/or urban communities.



Interested applicants should have a current interest in rural or underserved healthcare, and be currently enrolled in an eligible health professions degree or certificate program.



Program duration is one year for certificate programs and two years for undergraduate and graduate programs, with some exceptions.

40 hours of community-based, experiential, or clinical training in rural and/or underserved areas.

The clinical training used to meet your academic requirements may count for your AHEC Scholar clinical requirement.

Online Learning

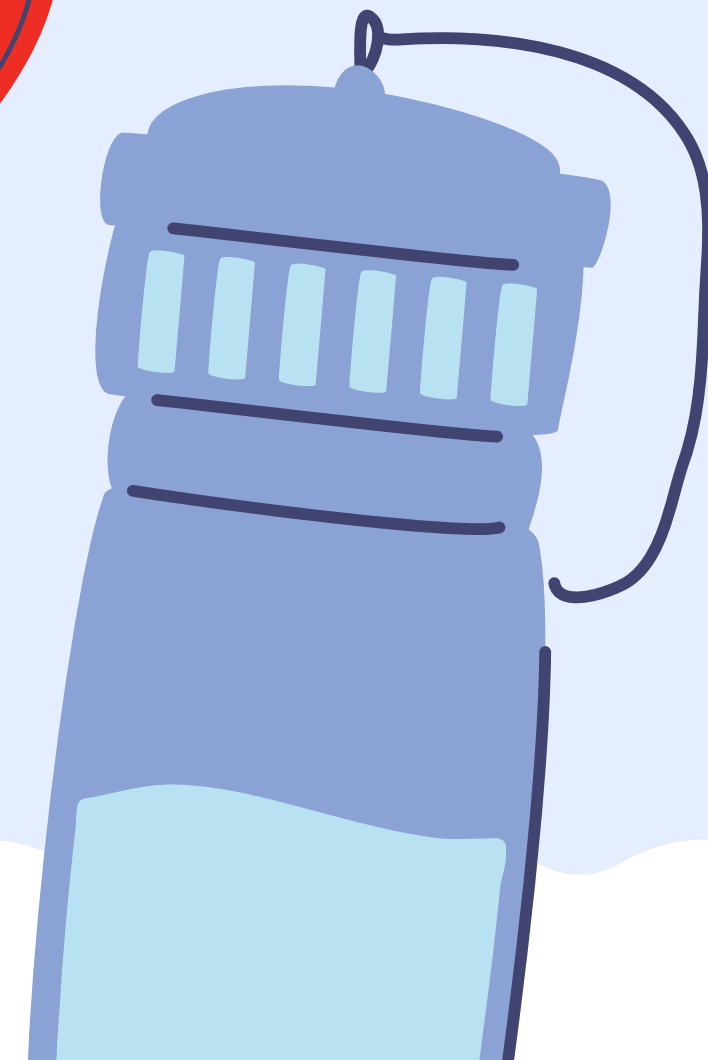
40 hours self-paced online education focusing on the following core topic areas

Financial Assistance

Panhandle AHEC Scholars will earn an \$800 stipend upon completion of each year of the AHEC Scholars program to be paid as soon as that year's requirements are completed.

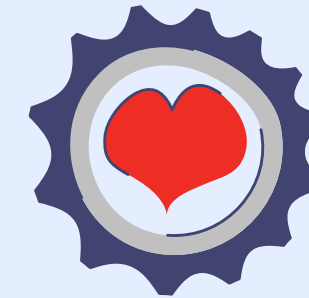
Interprofessionalism
