
Data Bite # 18 – 6-Year Graduation Rate by Ethnicity



6 Year Graduation Rates

Graduation rates measure the percentage of first-time full-time undergraduate students who complete their program at the same institution within a specified period. As it does with 4-year and 8-year graduation rates, WTAMU tracks graduation rates of first-time full-time undergraduate students within 6-years of the beginning of their program. The University publishes this continuously and updates these data visualizations on dashboards within the Institutional Effectiveness website. At the beginning of the Fall 2022 semester, WTAMU achieved a 6-year graduation rate of 45.3%.

Graduation Rates by Race/Ethnicity

This data bite takes a little deeper dive into 6-year graduation rates by breaking it down by race/ethnicity. There is an overall understanding that not all groups graduate at equal rates. Student success is a key driver on campus. The graph below shows the trend of 6-year graduation rates for each group over the last 5 years. Overall, each group is trending in the right direction.
