
## WHAT DOES THE SPRING '24 UNDERGRADUATE CLASS LOOK LIKE?

## 12th Class Day Facts

The 12<sup>th</sup> class day enrollment numbers are in for Spring 2024. The data bite above is meant to depict what a professor would see when looking out into their classroom.

This semester we have focused on breaking down the undergraduate class into geographical categories. Students from in-state, the Texas Panhandle (Region 16 and 17), the Top 26 counties and a direct bordering state (New Mexico, Oklahoma)

As a regional university that focuses on serving the Panhandle region of Texas, it is fitting that 53% of the undergraduate class comes from Region 16. The main group in the Top 26 Counties is from Potter and Randall County making up 63%.

The Tri State Area of New Mexico, Oklahoma and Colorado make up 6% of undergraduate out of state enrollment.
