Institutional Effectiveness has returned with its latest start-of-semester data update, offering a detailed look into three key areas: student demographics, transfer statistics, and retention metrics.

Student Demographics

For Spring 2025, undergraduates are enrolled in an average of 12 semester credit hours, with ranges between 2 and 24. Among the 6318 undergraduate students, the average age is 23, and 28.3% are residing on campus. College of Agriculture and Natural Sciences boasts the highest enrollment, accounting for 21% of the student body, while the most popular majors are Animal Science (364), General Business (315) and Pre-Engineering (309).

Transfer Facts

Transfer students constitute 42.4% of the Spring 2025 undergraduate class, with 370 new transfers joining this semester. Amarillo College continues to be the leading source of these transfer students.

Retention Facts

92.3% of the first-time-in-college cohort was retained from fall to spring, while 87.1% of new fall transfers were retained through the following fall.
