

House Bill 2504

Students often register for courses with little insight into what the semester will look like, or check for details about their professor. With House Bill 2504, students are able to look at past course syllabi to see what was assigned in previous semesters, course evaluations from former students, as well as their professors' curriculum vitae to gain a better understanding of their academic backgrounds.

The Texas Legislature passed the <u>Texas House Bill 2504</u> in 2009. These statutory provisions are now included in Section 51.974 of the Texas Education Code (TEC). This legislation requires institutions to provide the following information online for undergraduate courses within a week of the first class of each semester:

- 1. a curriculum vitae (CV) for each instructor
- 2. a syllabus for each class
- 3. departmental budget information
