



## Growth of the New Amarillo Center

Amarillo Center has had a steady growth since its opening in 2017. Starting with just 136 students in 2018, the center experienced a notable increase in enrollment, reaching a peak of 1,140 students in 2021. While there was a slight dip in 2022 and 2023, the numbers rebounded in 2024, and a projected 1,267 students are expected in 2025, though that number is still preliminary as the Fall 2025 enrollment numbers have yet to be finalized.
