



Spring 2026 Enrollment – Things to Know

Spring 2026 is shaping up to be a strong semester at WTAMU, with key enrollment indicators reflecting continued student commitment and university growth. Retention of first-time-in-college students from fall to spring is leading the way at an impressive **90.4%**, showing that new students are finding their place, making connections, and choosing to continue their academic journey at WT. Additionally, **47% of students this spring are first-generation**, highlighting WTAMU's ongoing dedication to supporting trailblazing students and ensuring they have the resources to succeed.

Transfer students continue to be an important part of our community, with **392 new transfers** joining WT this spring. The PUP (Provisional Undergraduate Program) also reflects positive momentum, with **22 more students** from this past semester leading to **249 PUP students** this spring, Fall 2025, demonstrating the university's commitment to offering flexible pathways for student success. Overall enrollment has increased by **1.0%**, showcasing WT's growing reputation as a welcoming and supportive institution for learners of all backgrounds.

These numbers illustrate more than just enrollment trends, they reflect student confidence in WTAMU's academic experience, campus community, and commitment to student success. Whether students are beginning their journey, transferring in, or coming back for another semester, WT continues to be a place where students feel supported, empowered, and inspired to achieve more.
