As highlighted in the graphic, homeschool enrollment at WT continues to grow each year, from 104 students in 2022 to 143 students in 2025. This steady increase reflects WT’s commitment to creating strong partnerships with homeschool communities and offering a smooth, supportive transition from home education to university life. Whether through dual enrollment, scholarships, or flexible admission pathways like the Pre-University Program (PUP), WT ensures homeschool students have access to valuable opportunities and personalized support.

Homeschool students at WT benefit from a university experience that combines academic excellence with a close-knit community. With a 18:1 student-to-faculty ratio, students receive individual attention from professors who are deeply invested in their success. This environment allows homeschool students to feel known, supported, and connected from day one.
