¹ **CORE:** Wildlife Biology majors are required to take specific courses for Core 20, Core 30, and Core 90. For all other categories, they may select from any available options (see degree checklist). Apart from the major-specific core requirements, there is no set order in which core courses must be taken.

² **Wildlife BIOL Electives:** Choose 6 total from the following list, three of the 6 classes chosen must have a lab: BIOL 2420 or 2572, BIOL 3309, BIOL 3301, BIOL 3418, BIOL 3510, BIOL 4098 (3 hrs min.), BIOL 4335, BIOL 4351, BIOL 4416, BIOL 4425, BIOL 4431, BIOL 4432, BIOL 4460, BIOL 4480, ENVR 4302, ENVR 4305, or one class from PSES 3350 or 3354 or 4302 or 4352.

Additional notes:

- The core curriculum must total exactly 42 hours; excess hours must be moved to the major as an elective or a major requirement and stay within the 120-hour requirement or approved total submitted to the Coordinating Board for degree requirements. Some majors specify particular courses to meet core curriculum requirements when options are available.
- At least 36 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU. A maximum of six semester hours in religion (RELI) and six semester hours in physical education (PHED) courses can count toward a baccalaureate degree.
