¹ **CORE:** Art majors are required to take a specific course (ARTS 1303) for Core 50. For all other categories, they may select from any available options (see degree checklist). Apart from the major-specific core requirements, there is no set order in which core courses must be taken.

² **Art History:** ARTS 4370 and 4371 are required. Take an additional 5 courses from ARTS 3302, 3392, 4370, or 4371.

³ **Electives:** Take 18 hours from the following subjects: art, history, English, philosophy, theatre, dance, or music. And take additional electives in any subject to total 120 overall.

Note: 15 hours of electives must be advanced in order to complete the required 36 advanced hours at WTAMU. May take up to 9 hours of ARTS courses (not to exceed 60 hours of ARTS total)

Additional notes:

- The core curriculum must total exactly 42 hours; excess hours must be moved to the major as an elective or a major requirement and stay within the 120-hour requirement or approved total submitted to the Coordinating Board for degree requirements. Some majors specify particular courses to meet core curriculum requirements when options are available.

- At least 36 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU. A maximum of six semester hours in religion (RELI) and six semester hours in physical education (PHED) courses can count toward a baccalaureate degree.
