¹ CORE: Music Therapy majors are required to take BIOL 2401 and BIOL 2402 for Core 30; ANTH 2351E for Core 40 (recommended, or another Core 40 course plus SOCI 1301); MUSI 1307 for Core 50; PSYC 2301 for Core 80. For all other categories, they may select from any available options (see degree checklist). Apart from the major-specific core requirement, there is no set order in which core courses must be taken.

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Additional notes:

- The core curriculum must total exactly 42 hours; excess hours must be moved to the major as an elective or a major requirement and stay within the 120-hour requirement or approved total submitted to the Coordinating Board for degree requirements. Some majors specify particular courses to meet core curriculum requirements when options are available.
- At least 36 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU. A maximum of six semester hours in religion (RELI) and six semester hours in physical education (PHED) courses can count toward a baccalaureate degree.

The degree checklist (later a student's official degree plan) should be referred to as the comprehensive list of all courses required for the degree.
