WT's Transfer Ambassadors are proud to present West Texas A&M University's 8th Annual Festival of Trees! The Festival of Trees is a chance for faculty, staff, and students to showcase their creativity while helping the community and the University.

Join us in the JBK Hallway (east side of Legacy Hall) November 23 through November 25 at designated times. Bring your decorations and we will provide the tree! Tree decorating will occur through specified time slots. Once this registration form is returned to The Student Success Center (The HUB) or emailed to <u>tldavis@wtamu.edu</u>, a link will be sent to the email listed on the form to select a decoration time. Only four participants are allowed per group. Names and email addresses of each participant must be submitted with the sign up form in the comments section.

Tree Specifications:

WTAMU Transfer Ambassadors are providing the trees, we just need you to provide decorations and a festive spirit! Submit your registration form early so you can get the time slot you want.

We urge you to use lights on the tree, as it will be going to an area family, just be aware that you will not be able to plug the lights in on campus. If you use battery lights, plan on supplying spare batteries to go with the tree when it is given to a local family. We recommend using plastic lights as they are less likely to break. Non-breakable decorations only i.e. non-glass ornaments. No water features, glitter, or aerosol snow of any kind can be used to decorate the tree. If it makes a mess, don't use it!

These trees are donated to families through the Canyon Angel Tree Project.

Transfer Ambassadors and West Texas A&M University reserve the right to alter any decorations at their discretion.

Display Sign:

A sign will be included to mark your tree so others will know who created the masterpiece. Please do not move display signs as they are required for social distancing practices.

What Happens to the Trees:

On December 21, the trees will be used for the Canyon Angel Tree project in Canyon and then taken home from the project by one of the families.
