WTAMU Summer Horsemanship Camps are designed to provide high- quality instruction from Equine Program faculty and students to individuals of varied riding skill and horse knowledge. Clinics are planned youth ages 5-18 the opportunity to ride and learn more about horses, their behavior and care in a safe and fun environment.

HORSES AND TACK

WTAMU has over 35 well-trained, gentle horses suitable for riders ranging in ability from beginning to advanced. We will provide tack and helmets as well. If you have your own tack or helmet, you are welcome to bring it, provided it is checked for safety.
