The WTAMU Faculty Advisory Council (FAC) meeting started at 12:15 p.m. in OM 317.

1. Dr. Wendler remarks

2. Opening remarks (Dr. Bang)

- Suggested that FAC members send college faculty email summaries of FAC meetings to solicit feedback.
- Created a FAC membership roster.
- Meeting minutes will be posted online, once approved by FAC during the following FAC meetings.
- Dr. Bang is in the Texas A&M Chancellor Advisory Council and the Texas Council of Faculty Senates.
- Comprehensive peer evaluations (CPE) of tenured faculty. FAC will talk about this at the next meeting.

3. College reports

- ANS: Study abroad trips; Regents Professor; Student research
- COB: Buff Business Summits; Mind Spark; an online magazine featuring professors' blog posts; study abroad next May
- ESS: 20 Ed.D. graduates; Buff Teacher Residency; enhanced teacher residency certificate
 - Dr. Wendler added: received a \$2 million grant from the Dept. of Education to support the teaching of civics. Will collaborate with other universities across Texas.
- COE: enrollment increased by 5%; a Ph.D. program in computational science and engineering is under review; additional state funding on engineering research; a new faculty member next semester
- FAH: Subscription Series (Can You COMM, two more events next semester); art events by FAH faculty and students; Communication graduate students will host a panel at an academic conference next semester; Emily Dickinson's sculpture in the library



- NHS: Faculty achievements (Dr. Price as SES department head, Dr. Brown joined a national committee on adapted PE, Dr. Fredman had a new publication); collaborative research within the college; Nursing is developing a DNP program and an Emergency NP program

4. New business

- Dr. Bang:
 - FAC will keep the Magister Optimus award. FAC will recommend candidates.
 - FAC will continue coordinating the university committees concerned with shared governance. FAC will recommend committee members. The list of committees is shared with FAC members.
 - Ombuds officer: The current Ombuds officer's term ends this year. The FAC will need to recommend an Ombuds officer for a two-year term next semester. Interested faculty members might need to go through an application process—more details to be discussed later.
 - FAC will create an anonymous Google Doc named “Faculty Insight Portal” to solicit feedback.
 - Dr. Bang will ask the Registrar’s Office about final grades due time: is it possible to extend it from 9 am to a later time on Monday?

5. Merit subcommittee report

- Dr. Brooks: The subcommittee has sent out a questionnaire to department heads and direct supervisors to gather their opinions. The survey deadline is January.
