- 1-hour Introduction to Honors, HNRS 2171, taken the first fall semester in the program
- Successful completion of ONE of three pathways: Traditional (6-8 hours of Core Curricula in Honors format), Cultural Studies (Extensive Study Abroad experience or 6-8 hours of foreign language coursework completed at WTAMU), or Service Emphasis (One extended service project, also requires 3 Seminar courses)
- 6-9 hours of Honors Seminars depending on above selected pathway
- Register for HNRS 2073, Honors Colloquia, each fall and spring semester
- Attend a minimum of one Honors Colloquia event each fall and spring semester
- Attend mandatory Honors meeting each semester (Fall Retreat, Spring Refresher)
- Completion of an Honors Senior Capstone/Thesis project and course
- A minimum of one presentation at a research conference
- Maintain GPA requirements below to remain in good standing with the Attebury Honors Program
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher with a 3.0 GPA or better in all Honors required courses required for graduation as an Attebury Honors Scholar
 - *Cumulative GPA of* 3.25/3.35 or higher based on overall hours required for continued participation. Subject to review each semester.

I understand that the above requirements must be met along with a minimum participation over 4 continuous long semesters. Additionally, as an Attebury Honors Student, I should conduct myself appropriately in accordance with the WTAMU Code of Student Life and use respectful communication with the WTAMU community.
