# The following scholarships are awarded once you have:

- 1) been accepted for admission,
- met the necessary criteria for the scholarship with official documentation, applied for financial aid through submission of the FAFSA, and cleared verification while funds are still available (by July 31st for the fall and Dec. 1st for the spring).

Even though this scholarship is automatic, which means it doesn't require a scholarship application, you will receive official notification of your award to accept and write a thank you letter. This notification will also include additional information about the requirements for your scholarship.

#### Resident Transfer Assistance Scholarship

\$2,000/yr for up to 2 years

- · 3.0 GPA + 30 transfer credit hours
- · Texas resident
- · FAFSA application submitted 60 days prior to the first day of class
- Enrolled full-time (minimum of 12 hours per term, Fall and Spring)

# Non-resident Transfer Assistance Scholarship

\$1,000/yr for up to 2 years

- 3.0 GPA + 30 transfer credit hours
- Non-Texas resident or International Student
- Enrolled full-time (12 or more hours per term, Fall and Spring)

#### President's Transfer Scholarship

\$3,000/yr for up to 2 years

- 3.5 GPA + 60 transfer credit hours
- · U.S. citizen
- · Enrolled full-time (12 or more hours per term, Fall and Spring)\*
