Health Sciences Degree

- Students may select an option of either Pre-Healthcare Professional or Healthcare Administration.

Degree Options

Pre-Healthcare Professional Option

- For students who plan to pursue a graduate degree in Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Nursing, Physician's Assistant, or other fields of professional healthcare that focus on patient care.
- This option is also for students who are currently certified/licensed or plan to become certified/licensed in a specific field in allied health (Dental Hygiene, Occupational Therapist Assistant, Physical Therapist Assistant, Radiologic Technology, Respiratory Therapist, or other fields in allied health that focus on patient care).

Healthcare Administration Option

- For students who want a career in one of the numerous areas of healthcare administration (Human Resources, Financial Management, Health Informatics, Hospital Management, or other areas of healthcare administration).
- This option also helps prepare students to pursue a graduate degree in business administration, healthcare management, or public health. These graduate degrees enable students to secure a position in the upper levels of healthcare management (Hospital CEO, Nursing Home CEO, Medical Practice Director, Health Care Consultant, or other positions that oversee specific areas of healthcare administration).
