Transfer Application

1. Apply online at www.wtamu.edu/apply.
2. Pay \$55 application fee or request an **application fee waiver**.
3. Submit official **college transcripts** from **all** institutions attended. If you have less than 12 hours, please follow steps for Freshman Applications.
4. Contact your **academic department** for additional applications requirements.

Transfer Credit Hours*

Minimum GPA (4.0 Scale)

< 12 hours	2.0 GPA and must meet freshman requirements**
≥ 12 hours	2.0 GPA

*Duel credit and coursework in progress do not count toward transferrable credit hours.

**Applicants must submit an official high school transcript with class rank and ACT/SAT scores.
