

## 2. SPECIFICATIONS

2.1 Any catalogue, brand name or manufacturer's reference used in the Invitation for Bid is descriptive only (not restrictive), and is used to indicate type and quality desired. Bids on brands of like nature and quality will be considered unless otherwise specified. If bidding on other than reference, bid should show manufacturer, brand or trade name, and other description of the product offered. If other than brand(s) specified is offered, illustrations and complete description of product offered are requested to be made part of the bid. If bidder fails to take an exception to specifications or reference data in his or her bid, bidder will be required to furnish brand names, numbers, etc., as specified in the IFB.

2.2 All items shall be new and unused, in first class condition, including containers suitable for shipment and storage, unless otherwise indicated in IFB.

2.3 All electrical items must meet all applicable OSHA standards and regulations, and bear the appropriate listing from UL, FMRC or NEMA.

2.4 Samples, when requested, must be furnished free of expense to WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY. If not destroyed in examination, they will be returned to the bidder, upon request, at bidder's expense. Each sample should be marked with bidder's name and address, and WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY bid number. Do not enclose in or attach bid to sample.

2.5 WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY will not be bound by any oral statement or representation contrary to the written specifications of this IFB.

2.6 Manufacturer's standard warranty shall apply unless otherwise stated in the IFB.

3. TIE BIDS – In case of tie bids, the award will be made in accordance with Rule 1 TAC Section 113.6 (b) (3) and 113.8 (preferences).

## 4. DELIVERY

4.1 Bid should show number of calendar days required to place material in receiving agency's designated location under normal conditions. Failure to state delivery time obligates supplier to complete delivery in 14 calendar days. Unrealistically short or long delivery promises may cause bid to be disregarded.

4.2 If delay is foreseen, vendor shall give written notice to WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY. WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY has the right to extend delivery date if reasons appear valid. Vendor must keep the ordering agency advised at all times of status of order. Default in promised delivery (without accepted reasons) or failure to meet specifications authorizes WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY to purchase supplies elsewhere and charge full increase, if any, in cost and handling to defaulting vendor.

4.3 No substitutions or cancellation permitted without written approval of the WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY PURCHASING DEPARTMENT.

4.4 Delivery shall be made during normal working hours only, unless prior approval for late delivery has been obtained from WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY.

5. INSPECTION AND TESTS – All goods will be subject to inspection and test by WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY to the extent practicable at all times and places. Authorized WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY personnel shall have access to any supplier's place of business for the purpose of inspecting

merchandise. Tests shall be performed on samples submitted with the bid or on samples taken from regular shipment. In the event products tested fail to meet or exceed all conditions and requirements of the specifications, the cost of the sample used and the cost of the testing shall be borne by the supplier. Goods which have been delivered and rejected in whole or in part may, at West Texas A&M University's option, be returned to the supplier or held for disposition at supplier's risk and expense. Latent defects may result in revocation of acceptance.

6. **AWARD OF CONTRACT** – A response to an IFB is an offer to contract with WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY based upon the terms, conditions and specifications contained in the IFB. Bids do not become contracts until they are accepted and an authorized purchase order is issued. The contract shall be governed, construed and interpreted under the laws of the State of Texas. 8. **PATENTS OR COPYRIGHTS** – The supplier agrees to protect WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY from claims involving infringement of patents or copyrights.
9. **SUPPLIER ASSIGNMENTS** – Supplier hereby assigns to purchaser any and all claims for overcharges associated with this contract which arise under the antitrust laws of the United States 15 U.S.C.A. Section 1, et seq. (1973), and which arise under the antitrust laws of the State of Texas, TEX. Bus. & Comm. Code Ann. Sec. 15.01, et seq. (1967).
10. **BIDDER AFFIRMATION** – Signing this bid with a false statement is a material breach of contract and shall void the submitted bid or any resulting contracts, and the bidder shall be removed from all bid lists. By signature hereon affixed, the bidder hereby certifies that:

- (c) Compliance with the contested case process provided in subchapter C is a condition precedent to seeking consent to sue from the Legislature under Ch. 107 of the Civil Practices and Remedies Code.   - (2) Neither the occurrence of an event nor the pendency of a claim constitutes grounds for the suspension of the performance by vendor, in whole or in part.
  - (3) The designated individual responsible on behalf of WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY for examining any claim or counterclaim and conducting any negotiations related thereto, as required under 2260.052 of the Texas Government Code shall be Mr. Randy Rikel.
14. NON-APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS: The State's funds are contingent on the availability of lawful appropriations by the Texas Legislature. If the Texas Legislature fails to continue funding for the payments due under an order referencing this contract, the order will terminate as the date that the funding expires, and the State will have no further obligation to make any payments.
15. PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT:
- (a) [PROVIDER] acknowledges that WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY is obligated to strictly comply with the Public Information Act, Chapter 552, *Texas Government Code*, in responding to any request for public information pertaining to this Agreement, as well as any other disclosure of information required by applicable Texas law.
  - (b) Upon WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY'S written request, [PROVIDER] will provide specified public information exchanged or created under this Agreement that is not otherwise excepted from disclosure under chapter 552, Texas Government Code, to West Texas A&M University in a non-proprietary format acceptable to WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY. As used in this provision, "public information" has the meaning assigned Section 552.002, *Texas Government Code*, but only includes information to which WEST TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY has a right of access.
