\*\*The 100-Mile Waiver is given to all US residents of CO, KS, NM, and OK their first semester; however, an undergraduate student who drops below a cumulative 2.0 GPA will no longer be eligible for the waiver. Students who fall below the minimum requirement will be notified by the Office of the Registrar, and will be billed at Out-of-State, US Resident rates without the applied waiver shown on the table (see white column above.)

**Course-based, Differential Tuition is charged by the following Colleges/Schools:**

- College of Agriculture and Natural Sciences Differential Tuition - \$26.55 per SCH
- College of Business and Engineering/Computer Science Differential Tuition - \$37.75 per SCH
- College of Nursing Differential Tuition - \$44.35 per SCH
