West Texas A&M University Panhandle Plains Historical Museum Analysis of Facility Condition Assessment Friday, March 14, 2025

WTAMU engaged Alpha Facilities Solutions to conduct a facilities condition assessment of the Panhandle Plains Historical Museum in February 2025. All critical and essential building systems including but not limited to roofing, HVAC, electrical and plumbing, were examined and summarized by this report.

It was determined that the facility, which contains the original building built in 1932 and the five additions, is generally in poor condition. Many of the buildings systems have exceeded recommended useful life and several systems, including high priority systems, are in need of repair and/or replacement due to deterioration and damage.
