2	relating to the operation and management of the Panhandle-Plains
3	Historical Museum by the Texas Historical Commission.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 442, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter B-3 to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER B-3. PANHANDLE-PLAINS HISTORICAL MUSEUM
8	Sec. 442.067. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "museum"
9	means the Panhandle-Plains Historical Museum in Canyon, Texas.
10	Sec. 442.068. PANHANDLE-PLAINS HISTORICAL MUSEUM; FUND.
11	(a) The museum currently consists of a facility on the campus of
12	West Texas A&M University and a collection owned by the
13	Panhandle-Plains Historical Society.
14	(b) To the extent authorized by law, the commission may
15	enter into a contract with the Panhandle-Plains Historical Society
16	for the operation and management of the museum. The commission may
17	also enter into a contract with West Texas A&M University or The
18	Texas A&M University System, as needed for the construction,
19	renovation, expansion, maintenance, or management of museum
20	facilities on the campus of West Texas A&M University.
21	(c) The contract with the Panhandle-Plains Historical
22	Society authorized by this section must include provisions for:
23	(1) expanding, renovating, managing, maintaining,
24	operating, or providing financial support for the museum collection

- 1 and museum facility and related assets;
- 2 (2) <u>preserving the museum's collection;</u>
- 3 (3) employing a museum director and other employees
- 4 the commission considers necessary to fulfill its duties and
- 5 responsibilities under the contract;
- 6 (4) accepting donations of money, property, and
- 7 <u>historical relics; and</u>
- 8 <u>(5) acquiring property and historical relics with</u>
- 9 funds available for that purpose.
- 10 <u>(d) The Panhandle-Plains Historical Museum fund is created</u>
- 11 as a fund outside the state treasury. The commission shall
- 12 administer the fund but may contract with the Panhandle-Plains
- 13 Historical Society for administration of the fund. The fund
- 14 consists of:
- 15 (1) admissions revenue from the operation of the
- 16 museum;
- 17 (2) sales revenue from the operation of the museum
- 18 gift shop; and
- 19 (3) donations made to the commission for the museum.
- 20 (e) Money in the Panhandle-Plains Historical Museum fund
- 21 may be spent without legislative appropriation and only to
- 22 <u>administer</u>, operate, preserve, repair, expand, or otherwise
- 23 maintain the museum.
- 24 (f) Interest and income from the assets of the
- 25 Panhandle-Plains Historical Museum fund shall be credited to and
- 26 deposited in the fund.
- 27 SECTION 2. Section 61.003(6), Education Code, is amended to

- 1 read as follows:
- "Other agency of higher education" means The University (6) 2 3 of Texas System, System Administration; The University of Texas at El Paso Museum; Texas Epidemic Public Health Institute at The 4 5 University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston; The Texas A&M University System, Administrative and General Offices; Texas A&M 6 AgriLife Research; Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service; Rodent and 7 8 Predatory Animal Control Service (a part of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service); Texas A&M Engineering Experiment Station 9 10 (including the Texas A&M Transportation Institute); Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service; Texas A&M Forest Service; Texas 11 12 Division of Emergency Management; Texas Tech University Museum; Texas State University System, System Administration; Sam Houston 13 14 Memorial Museum; [Panhandle-Plains Historical Museum;] Cotton 15 Research Committee of Texas; Texas Water Resources Institute; Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory; and any other unit, 16 17 division, institution, or agency which shall be so designated by statute or which may be established to operate as a component part 18 19 of any public senior college or university, or which may be so classified as provided in this chapter. 20
- SECTION 3. On September 1, 2025, an employee of West Texas
 A&M University assigned exclusively to the museum becomes an
 employee of the commission.
- SECTION 4. Section 102.35, Education Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
