NEW STUDENT CHECKLIST

 - a. This breaks your bill down by charges, payments, financial aid and refunds.

NAVIGATING TO THE PAYMENT PORTAL

- 1. Go to the WTAMU website
- 2. Select "Buff Connect"
- 3. Enter your login information
- 4. Complete the DUO authentication
- 5. Select "Buff Advisor"
- 6. Select "Student Finance"
- 7. Select the "Make Payment/Payment Plan Link"
- 8. Select "Continue to Payment Center"



PAYMENT PLAN & AUTOMATIC PAYMENTS

- 1. Follow steps 1-8 above on page 1
- 2. Select "Enroll in Payment Plan" *
- 3. Next to desired plan, select "Select"
- 4. To enroll in automatic payments, select "Yes, I want to set up my payments. Let me chose the payment method that will automatically be used to make a payment on each due date." **
- 5. Select "Continue"

**if there is a remaining unpaid balance after December 1st, a restrictive hold will be placed on the account preventing registration for future semesters*

Payment Plan Options

*<u>5-Month Installment Plan:**</u>

- Calculated on the account balance before financial aid.
- Example:
 - Tuition and Fees: \$4,000
 - Room and Board: \$4,500
 - Account Balance: \$8,500 (before aid)
 - Installments: 5 payments of \$1,700
- The first payment is due before the semester starts and must be paid out of pocket.

*4-Month Installment Payment Plan - Option A:**

- Calculated on the account balance before financial aid.
- Example:
 - Account Balance: \$8,500
 - Installments: 4 payments of \$2,125
 - Financial aid can cover the first two installments.

<u>*4-Month Installment Payment Plan - Option B:**</u>

- Calculated on the account balance after financial aid.
- Example:
 - Account Balance after financial aid: \$5,000
 - Installments: 4 payments of \$1,250
- First payment due the month after the term starts.

*Important Notes:**

- Financial aid posts 10 days before classes start.
- Changing payment plans incurs a \$50 fee, and fees are non-refundable.

PAYMENT METHODS

- 4. Use the drop-down menu to select payment method*^
- 5. Fill all required fields
- 6. Select "continue"



*Credit/ Debit cards subject to 3% fee, \$3 transaction minimum ^Electronic Check is FREE to use

SPONSORED BILLING

Sponsored billing is a payment agreement made between West Texas A&M University and a government agency, either domestic or foreign, the student's employer, a pre-paid savings program, or another agency that will send payment on the student's behalf after WTAMU has invoiced the agency.

Sponsored billing is not a reimbursement program. Once sponsored billing is added to the student account, it is only a promise of payment by the agency. If the agency refuses to honor their agreement either in part or in full after they have been invoiced, sponsorship agreements must be adjusted to match the funds the sponsor submits for payment. Any remaining balance then becomes the responsibility of the student.

EMERGENCY LOANS (LAST RESORT)

WTAMU offers short-term emergency loans to eligible students who find that their anticipated payment method is delayed but still expected.

Emergency loans for tuition and fees are available beginning 10 to 12 days before the first payment deadline, and are available until the 20th class day for Fall and Spring, 4th class day for summer sessions, and 2nd class day for intersessions. Loans are due in full within 90 days for the Fall and Spring semesters, and 45 days for all other terms.

A confirmation number will be shown on the last screen when the loan application is completed. All applicants will receive an email in their Buff email account 1 to 2 business days after applying giving the status of their application.

Interest begins accruing when the loan is applied to the student's university balance as a payment at the rate of 5% annually. The maximum amount for tuition and fees is \$2500, or total charges for mandatory tuition and fees if the total is less than \$2500.00.

Some students whose scholarships, aid, and/or payments exceed their billed amount may be eligible for a refund of credit applied to their account. in order to receive the refund of credit, students will either be mailed a check, or receive the refund via direct deposit.

2025-2026 Student Financial Aid Checklist

*IMPORTANT**

Financial aid is not guaranteed to cover your entire bill. It is your responsibility as the student to learn how to use your My Buff account to check your bill and your financial aid, and to calculate whether your bill will be completely paid. If financial aid doesn't cover the full amount, it is your responsibility to pay the rest. If more money is needed, you can apply for an external education loan or your parent can apply for a Parent PLUS loan. This must be done prior to Finals

Helpful Hints for Financial Aid

- □ To receive financial aid, you must have filed a FAFSA using your name and social security number as listed on your social security card
- Log in to the WT Application portal and enter your social security number if it is requested there
- Promptly respond to ALL requests for information from WTAMU's Financial Aid and Admissions offices; you can't receive financial aid until all information is complete
- □ Include your name and student ID number on all paperwork and communication
- Frequently check your WTAMU e-mail and Buff Advisor

FAFSA Process

- Submit a 2025/2026 FAFSA at www.studentaid.gov including WTAMU's federal school code (003665)
- Check your FAFSA Submission Summary making sure all information is correct
- □ The FAFSA Submission Summary lists the answers you gave on your FAFSA and gives basic information about eligibility
- □ If **WTAMU** is not listed, submit a correction and add our federal school code (003665)
- □ Make corrections online as needed

FAFSA Account

- All contributors who provide information on the FAFSA must make a FAFSA account on <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>. A contributor will be the student, biological or adoptive parent, parents spouse, **OR** students spouse.
- □ It is best to create the account BEFORE starting the FAFSA application. Each FSA ID (account) will need a unique email address.
- Enter names and Social Security Numbers (SSN) exactly as listed on the Social Security Card.
- Contributors without an SSN can create a <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> account to fill out their portion of their students' FAFSA form online.

IMPORTANT DATES

*If Priority date is not met, financial aid is not guaranteed

January 15 of each year - Generally, the priority* date for FAFSA submitted for TEXAS Grant (postponed-Feb 15, 2025)

April 15 of each year - Priority* date for FAFSA submission for students attending in fall; FAFSA and scholarship application deadline for Buff Promise

June 15 of each year- Priority* date for TEXAS Grant recipients to have ALL documents submitted (including verification information)

June 30 of each year - Priority* date for incoming freshmen to have final official high school transcript submitted to WT Admissions for TEXAS Grant

October 1 of each year - Generally, FAFSA can be filed for the following school year (example: on Oct. 1, 2022, the FAFSA application opened for the 2023-2024 school year.) This year is tentatively delayed until Dec. 1st.

Student Loans for New Students and

Transfer Students

Three steps are required to receive student loans that help pay your WT Bill. The steps are:

- Accept the loan award through your Buff Advisor in the student portal.
- Complete Direct Loan Entrance Counseling <u>AND</u> the Master Promissory Note at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>
- Use the subsidized/unsubsidized option and list **WTAMU** as your school.

Transfer Students:

Transfer students who have previously received federal loan funding **MUST**:

- Complete Entrance Counseling for WTAMU
- Check the expiration date of your Master Promissory Note. <u>It will follow you to WT</u> <u>unless it has expired.</u>

Check your Student Portal

This student menu lists documents you are required to upload, and shows your financial aid once it is ready for you to accept.

- Click: "Complete Required Documents" or "Review and accept your Financial Aid Award Package"

Borrowing History

The federal government website, <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>, gives you information about federal grants and loans you received for each academic year at any school and includes loan servicer contact information for each loan. Another place to find the amount of student loans you owe is the last page of your FAFSA Submission Summary (refer to FAFSA Process on front for information on this report).

FERPA (Contributor access)

Log in to Buff Advisor and choose "User Options" on the left side. Next, Use "View/Add Proxy Access" to designate who you wish to allow access. Consider giving your parent(s) proxy to your financial information so that they can help you ensure that your bill is paid.

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

We check Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) after every spring semester. Your Academic Progress must be Satisfactory to continue receiving financial aid. You can see the University SAP policy at WTAMU.edu by searching for Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Federal Student Aid homepage

For federal student aid, <u>www.studentaid.gov</u> is a 'one stop' page with extensive information about financial aid including grants, work-study, and student/parent loans.

Make all checks payable to **West Texas A&M University**. If the donor prefers to make the check co-payable to the student and WTAMU, proceeds **cannot** be applied until the student endorses the check.

Please include the following with each check.

- •Contact information (organization or donor name, address, phone number)
- •Student's/ Recipient's Name
- •Student's ID/ Buffalo Gold Card number, if known or another source of identifying information such as birthday, address, etc.
- •Disbursement Letter/Instructions (e.g., Fall only, Spring only, 1/2 Fall or 1/2 Spring)

Procedures for External Scholarships via ACH If you are expecting an external scholarship from a donor via ACH, contact us at scholarships@wtamu.edu for further instructions. We cannot give out ACH information to anyone other than the donor.

Students may accrue late fees if external scholarship checks are not received prior to the bill date. Students should contact the Business Office at **bo@wtamu.edu** to discuss payment options if scholarship checks do not arrive by the bill due date. Graduate without owing a fortune.
