Panhandle Transit

- There is no set schedule for the Panhandle Transit
- Within Amarillo, there is a \$2.00 charge per stop. \$30 monthly passes are also available.
- Call 800-800-6162 at least 24 hours in advance for a ride

Uber— you will need to download the Uber app on your phone

Taxi Services— please search for taxi services in the Canyon/Amarillo Area

Electric Scooters

-You might have seen these scooters all around campus and apartment buildings.

-These are called “Bird” and they are available for anyone to use within short distances.

-You need to download the app called “Bird” on your phone, scan the QR code, and make the required payment before use.

MAINTAINING F1 VISA STATUS BASICS

Undergraduates

- *A full course load is considered 12 credit hours
- *At least 9 credit hours (3 courses) must be face-to-face
- *Students may take one (1) online course as part of the full course load
- *Students are welcome to take more than 12 credit hours per semester
- *If you are unable to take a full course load for ANY reason, please contact the Office of Admission-International.



Graduates

- *A full course load is considered 9 credit hours
- *At least 6 credit hours (2 courses) must be face-to-face
- *Students may take one (1) online course as part of the full course load
- *Students are welcome to take more than 9 credit hours per semester
- *If you are unable to take a full course load for any reason, please contact the Office of Admission-International.

All Students

- *Make sure your passport is valid at all times
- *When traveling outside of the US, please visit the ISS to get your I-20 signed for travel
- *When traveling outside of the US, make sure your visa is valid (visa doesn't need to be valid if staying in the US)

Retrieving Your I-94 (Arrival/ Departure record)

- This document is required to apply for employment, open a bank account, drivers license, etc.

3. Enter the information and click Next

ON-CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT & GETTING A SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

On-Campus Employment

*Students on an F1 visa may work up to 20 hours per week on-campus for the Fall and Spring semesters. During official university breaks, international students may work up to 40 hours per week on-campus

Off-campus work is strictly prohibited on the F1 student visa, per federal regulations

If you wish to work for the on-campus Starbucks, Pony Express, Wich Wich, and/or Chick-Fil-A, you must ensure the employer is Aramark.

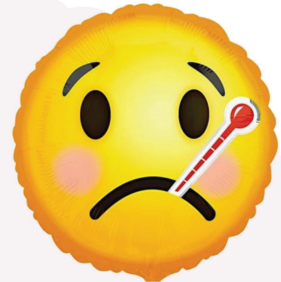

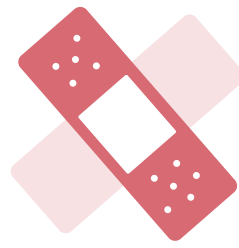

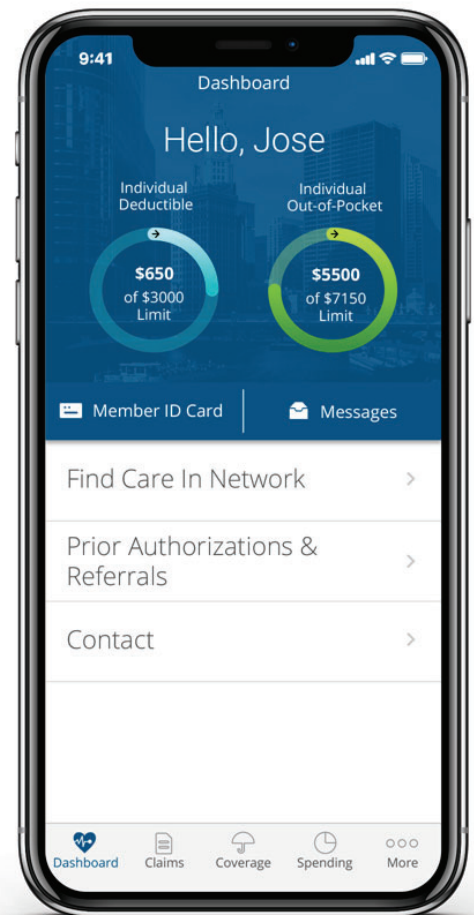
