___ I must attend the mandatory in-person immigration orientation upon my arrival into the US. You will be provided with the details of the orientation upon arrival.

___ If this is my final semester at WT, I must take a full courseload (9 hours for graduates; 12 hours for undergraduates).

___ I understand that I must take face-to-face classes while on the F1 student visa. Per federal Department of Homeland Security regulations, graduate students must take at least 9 credit hours, with 6 hours face-to-face. Undergraduates must take at least 12 credit hours, with 9 hours face-to-face.

___ Per federal Department of Homeland Security regulations, I am not eligible for CPT (internships) until I have completed at least 2 long semesters (Fall and Spring) in valid F1 visa status.

___ Per federal Department of Homeland Security regulations, I am not eligible for OPT (post-completion work authorization) until I have completed at least 2 long semesters (Fall and Spring) in valid F1 visa status.

___ Per federal Department of Homeland Security regulations, I cannot work off-campus under any circumstances. I can work on-campus up to 20 hours per week during the Fall and Spring semesters only. I can work on-campus up to 40 hours per week during official university breaks, including summer.
