NOTE: This is NOT a degree plan. All undergraduate students must request an official degree plan from their academic dean's office by the time they have completed 30 credit hours.



Note 1 - CORE: Theatre majors cannot receive core credit for THRE 1310. They are encouraged to take ENGL 1301 (Core 10) and MATH (Core 20) during their first year. For all other core categories, they may select from any available options (see degree checklist). There is no set order in which core courses must be taken.

Note 2 - Electives: At least 39 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU. No more than 60 hours in THRE can be counted toward this degree, so only two THRE electives can be taken.
