The open house featured five different input stations for students. Students provided different types of input at each station






#### Q1: How many years have you been at WT?


#### Q2: Do you live on campus?


# Q3: Please indicate your PRIMARY commuting mode (the longest distance) to campus each day ON A TYPICAL DAY. SELECT ONE.


#### Q4: Do you use the existing shuttle service?






#### Q7: Where is your favorite place on campus to study?


### Q8: Where is your favorite place on campus to gather and meet with friends?


#### Q13: How often during the semester do you go home for the weekend?




#### Q1: Are you a member of faculty or staff?

#### Q2: At which location do you predominately work?










