A maximum of 80 semester hours in music (MUSI, MUEN, MUAP), six hours in religion (RELI) and six hours in physical education (PHED) can be counted toward a degree.

NOTE: This is NOT a degree plan. After completing 30 hours, students are encouraged to request an official degree plan by using the online Degree Plan Request form. The dean's office of the Sybil B.
