NOTE I: At least 39 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) for which tuition is paid must be earned at WTAMU; 30 of the final 36 hours counted toward the degree must be earned at WTAMU. No more than 60 semester hours in art (ARTS) can be counted toward this degree. A maximum of six semester hours in religion (RELI) and a maximum of six semester hours in physical education (PHED) courses can count toward a baccalaureate

degree.

NOTE II: Art majors (B.A. or B.S.) interested in gallery management, museum work or other art/business possibilities should normally select Studio Art and Management or Art History Emphasis and take support courses in ACCT 2301, 2302, BUSI 1301, MKT 3340, MGT 3330, 3332 (prerequisites: ACCT 2301, ACCT 2302 and FIN 3320)
