NOTE I: This degree assumes completion of an associate of applied science degree at a community college or completion of an appropriate occupational certificate prior to starting work on the B.A.A.S. degree at WTAMU. Included in this credit must be a block of transfer of technical-vocational credits, up to a maximum of 48 hours Additional hours of academic credit may be transferred.

NOTE II: At least 39 hours of advanced work (3000- or 4000-level courses) are required for this degree. At least 30 of these hours must be from WTAMU; the other 9 may be from other RELLIS Academic Alliance institutions. A maximum of 60 semester hours in any single discipline, six hours in religion (RELI) and six hours in physical education (PHED) can be counted toward a degree.

NOTE: This is NOT a degree plan. After completing 30 hours, students are required to request an official degree plan by using the online **Degree Plan Request** form. Students who have completed 30 hours will not be allowed to progress without requesting a degree plan.
