### **Degree and Certification Plan Changes**

If you are a degree seeking candidate, your current degree plan is for the 36 semester credit hour (SCH) program. If you are a principal certification only candidate, your current certification plan is for the 30 SCH program. For either plan, if your degree or certification plan currently lists EDLD 6312 and EDLD 6394 or EDLD 6399, and a degree or certification plan change has not already been completed, contact Dr. Bigham at <a href="mailto:gbigham@wtamu.edu">gbigham@wtamu.edu</a> for advisement on needed changes. If you will be taking courses in the Fall 2018 semester, contact Dr. Bigham during the Summer 2 semester to request a degree or certification plan change from the 36 SCH degree plan to the 30 SCH degree plan or from the 30 SCH principal certification plan to the 24 SCH principal certification plan if you desire to transition to the reduced SCH plan. In your email, include a copy of your current transcript from Buff Advisor and ensure that your Buff ID number is in the email.

## **End of Program Tests**

- The <u>master's comprehensive exams</u> will be administered in April, July, and November. All degree seeking candidates must complete the <u>master's comprehensive exam</u> during or after their last semester of enrollment.
- The principal TEXES exam will be taken during enrollment in EDLD 6099 or EDLD 6299. Check your degree plan to ensure that you enroll in the right course(s) to fulfill your practicum requirement. EDLD 6099 was designed to temporarily take the place of EDLD 6312 and EDLD 6399. It is not anticipated that many (if any) are still in need of EDLD 6099 out of this group of candidates. EDLD 6299 was also designed to take the place of EDLD 6312 and EDLD 6399 in the proposed new program scheduled to begin in the Fall 2018 semester.
