

TIMELINE FOR CLINICAL TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS

Clinical teacher with one assignment

Week 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher begins observing and performing simple classroom tasks (e.g., checking roles, handling out supplies, monitoring students). • Clinical teacher prepares lesson plans for teaching one class/ subject the entire following week. Cooperating teacher gives advice. • The cooperating teacher allows time for discussions of school policy and classroom discipline.
Week 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher teaches one subject or one class period every day for this week. Cooperating teacher supervises and provides feedback. • Clinical teacher begins planning for the following week. • The cooperating teacher allows time to discuss plans with the clinical teacher and to provide explanations for teaching and management strategies.
Week 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher continues to teach the class/subjects from the previous week and add one more. Cooperating teacher continues to provide supervision and feedback. • Clinical teacher should begin plans for the following week.
Week 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher adds a third/subject.
Week 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher analyzes progress with university school liaison and cooperating teacher.
Week 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Add a fourth class if university school liaison and cooperating teacher agree.
Week 8 - 13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher assumes responsibility for the entire workday. Cooperating teacher may wish to leave the classroom more frequently during this time. • The cooperating teacher may videotape one or more classes for discussion with the clinical teacher and the university school liaison if possible. • Week 13 the cooperating teacher gradually begins to assume classes back
Week 14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cooperating teacher gradually begins to assume classes back. • Cooperating teacher should arrange for clinical teacher to observe in other classrooms during this week. Cooperating teacher will complete the summative evaluation and discuss it with the student/ clinical teacher.

The cooperating teacher is encouraged to make modifications in this calendar as necessary.

TIMELINE FOR CLINICAL TEACHING ASSIGNMENTS

Clinical teacher with two assignments

<p>Week 1</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher begins observing and performing simple classroom tasks (e.g., checking roles, handling out supplies, monitoring students). • Clinical teacher prepares lesson plans for teaching one class/ subject the entire following week. Cooperating teacher gives advice. • The cooperating teacher allows time for discussions of school policy, teaching philosophy, and classroom discipline. Clinical teacher should be encouraged to learn student's names.
<p>Week 2</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher teaches one subject or one class period every day for this week. Cooperating teacher supervises and provides feedback. • Clinical teacher begins planning for the following week. If possible, arrange for the clinical teacher to observe other teachers occasionally. • The cooperating teacher allows time to discuss plans with the clinical teacher and to provide explanations for teaching and management strategies.
<p>Week 3</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher continues to teach the class/subjects from the previous week and add one more. Cooperating teacher continues to provide supervision and feedback. • Clinical teacher should begin plans for the following week.
<p>Week 4</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher teaches four classes/ Subjects for the entire week. Plan for all-day teaching next week with input from cooperating teacher. • The cooperating teacher may wish to leave the classroom for brief periods. • Cooperating teacher will continue providing feedback on teaching and lesson planning.
<p>Week 5-7</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clinical teacher teaches the entire workday. • Clinical teacher teaches the entire workday and handles all normal teaching responsibilities. • The cooperating teacher will complete the summative evaluation and discuss it with the clinical teacher.

The cooperating teachers are encouraged to make modifications in this calendar as necessary for the teaching assignment.
